



HANNAH DIVINEY

A writer, disability advocate, actress, speaker and media personality, Hannah is one of Australia's most influential voices for disability rights and representation. A wheelchair user with cerebral palsy, she is known for her fearless advocacy, sharp wit, and ability to challenge ableism across media, policy and pop culture.

Hannah first gained national and international attention through her viral petition calling for a disabled Disney Princess, followed by successful campaigns that led global artists Lizzo and Beyoncé to amend ableist lyrics in their music. Her debut book, *I'll Let Myself In* (2023), is a powerful collection of personal essays exploring what it means to grow up in a world not built for you. Her writing has appeared in *The Guardian*, *Harper's Bazaar*, *Marie Claire*, *Mamamia*, and beyond, and she is the former Editor-in-Chief and co-founder of *Missing Perspectives*, a global media platform dedicated to amplifying the voices of women and girls.

"I'm hoping people come to the Expo and find something they actually need," Hannah says. "These events matter because they bring the community, service providers and decision-makers into the same space. When you see how interconnected everything is, it becomes much harder to ignore the realities of disabled people's lives."
